In order to streamline the participant recruitment process, we are creating a participant pool for HCI research. As a member of the pool, you will be notified whenever a new study becomes available. Agreeing to be contacted does not obligate you to take part in any study; you may decide to participate in the specific study at the time of each contact. Your name and contact details will be available only to members of the research team. This information will be accessed over an encrypted network and securely stored in a datacenter indefinitely until you delete your account, at which point the information will be deleted. You can also withdraw from the pool at any time.
